PRESS RELEASE

On Wednesday, February 3 at 3:46 pm, the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a motor vehicle accident that occurred near the intersection of K64 and Hwy 60, three miles south of Orange City, IA.

Peter Carlson, 35 of Ashton, IA was driving a 2002 Chevy Suburban northbound on Hwy 60. Carlson was pulling a utility trailer owned by the Sibley, IA Ocheydan School District. Carlson lost control of the vehicle and entered the south ditch. The suburban and trailer rolled onto the driver's side and struck a road sign owned by the State of Iowa.

No injuries were reported; Carlson was wearing his seatbelt.

The Suburban sustained approximately \$5,000 in damages, and the trailer had major damage.

Damage was also done to some band equipment that was in the trailer.

Carlson was cited for Failure to Maintain Control.

The Sheriff's Office was assisted by the Iowa State Patrol and the Iowa Department of Transportation.
