**PRESS RELEASE**

On Monday, January 25 at 3:46 pm, the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a four vehicle accident that occurred three miles north of Sioux Center, IA on Hwy 75.

Lea Van Regenmorter, age 43, from rural Sioux Center was driving a 2001 Ford F250 pickup, she was turning south onto Hwy 75 from County Road B30. Jordan Mulder, age 22, of Sioux Center was driving A 1995 Peterbuilt truck southbound on Hwy 75. Van Regenmorter was unable to see the semi coming; the vehicles collided within the intersection. Both vehicles slid into the east ditch.

Van Regenmorter was transported to the Sioux Center Hospital by the Sioux Center Ambulance for incapacitating injuries.

The F250 sustained major damage; the semi received approximately \$3,000 in damages.

After the initial collision, a 1998 Dodge Ram driven by Jeremiah Nelson, age 28 of Hull, IA slowed and came to a stop due to the northbound lane being blocked by the semi. Nelson's vehicle was struck from the rear by a 2006 Buick Rendezvous driven by Lori Delaney, age 46 of Pipestone, MN.

No injuries were reported in that accident.

The Dodge Ram sustained approximately \$2,000 in damages, while the Rendezvous received approximately \$5,000 in damages.

The Sioux County Sheriff's Office was assisted at the scene by the Sioux Center Ambulance and the Sioux Center Fire Department.
