**JANUARY 30, 2012 UNSOLVED BURGLARY**

On Monday, January 30, at 3:50 p.m., the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a burglary that occurred at 4090 320th Street, one mile east of Boyden, IA.

Upon further investigation, the sheriff's office found that sometime between Saturday, January 28 and Monday, January 30, someone entered the residence by breaking a window in a door.

**JANUARY 7, 2012 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Thursday, January 5, at 2:40 pm, the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a theft that occurred at a rural residence near Hull, IA.

Upon further investigation, the sheriff's office found that sometime between November 15, 2011 and January 3, 2012, someone stole about 500 gallons of gasoline from a farm location.

**OCTOBER 26, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Tuesday, October 25, at 8:15 am, the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a burglary that took place at 2798 360<sup>th</sup> Street, five miles northwest of Sioux Center, IA.

Sometime between Friday, October 21 and Sunday, October 23 someone entered the residence at this address and took a Playstation 3 along with some games, and a white dorm size refrigerator.

### **SEPTEMBER 3-4, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Sunday, September 4 at 8:00 a.m., the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated three vandalism incidents that occurred one mile north of Boyden, IA.

1. A vehicle was driving recklessly in the township cemetery at 3050 Jefferson Ave and struck a headstone.
2. A window of a nearby farm building in the 3900 block of 310<sup>th</sup> St was shot with what appears to have been a BB gun.
3. A mailbox was damaged near the intersection of Hwy 18 and Jefferson Ave.

### **MAY 18, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Tuesday, May 17, at 6:20 pm, the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated the theft of pigs from 5003 McKinley Ave, four miles south of Granville, IA. It was reported that sometime within the past two weeks approximately 98 Berkshire pigs were taken from a hog confinement at that location. The pigs are owned by Eden Farms from State Center, IA.

### **APRIL 26, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Monday April 25 the Sioux County Sheriff's Office received a report of a vandalism that occurred at 3819 Garfield Avenue, three miles northwest of Sioux Center. The residence is an abandoned farm place. The perpetrator(s) entered the farm house and broke nearly every window from the inside. The vandalism occurred sometime between Thursday April 21 and Saturday April 23.

### **MARCH 29, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

The Sioux County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating a theft from a vehicle that occurred on Main Street in Granville sometime between 8:00 p.m. on March 26 and 5:00 p.m. on March 27. A Red 1996 Honda Civic was parked outside of Main Street Bikes and Trikes in Granville. Access was gained to the vehicle through an open door. Taken was a HTC Aria Black phone that had not been activated; also taken was an I POD charger, cell phone charger, 2 X Box controllers, and a large amount of clothing.

### **MARCH 15, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Tuesday, March 15 at 11:49 a.m., the Sioux County Sheriff's Office received a report of two stolen Husqvarna chain saws. The chain saws were stored in a Raman Tree Service truck which was parked on Railroad Street in Hull, IA. The theft occurred sometime during the winter months. One chain saw has a three foot cut and the other has an 18 inch cut.

### **MARCH 2, 2011 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

The Sioux County Sheriff's Office is currently investigating a theft from an unoccupied vehicle. The theft

occurred at Maurice Precision Alignment and Repair in Maurice sometime between Friday, February 25 and Monday, February 28.

Access was gained to a 2000 International semi truck by breaking the passenger side window. A Cobra 29 LTD Classic CB Radio was taken from the truck.

**DECEMBER 27, 2010 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Monday, December 27 at 12:00 pm, the Sioux County Sheriff's Office investigated a theft and burglary that occurred at a rural Sioux Center, IA confinement building site. The burglary and subsequent theft occurred sometime between November 15 and December 13. Taken in the burglary was nails, screws, insulation, caulk and end caps valued at over \$6,000.

**NOVEMBER 26, 2010 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Friday, November 26, sometime during the daytime hours, a burglary occurred at a residence located approximately two miles southwest of Sioux Center, IA. Entry was gained through an unlocked door. Taken was approximately \$700 worth of DeWalt portable tools, a tan pet taxi, and a "White" portable electric heater. All tools have the initials of "bpb" on them.

A tan/silver full size pickup truck was seen at the farm place a week before the burglary and may be connected to it. It's believed to be a newer GMC or Chevrolet driven by a Hispanic male about 35 yrs of age.

**NOVEMBER 17 2010 TEXT-A-TIP CRIME**

On Wednesday, November 17, sometime during the daytime hours a burglary occurred at a residence located at 3091 370<sup>th</sup> St, one mile north of Sioux Center. Entry was gained through an unlocked door. Taken was about \$1,000 in rings and necklaces, some credit cards, and a small amount of blood pressure medication.
